The first week of school will be as follows:

Monday, Sept. 9 – first day for Pre-k/Tk classes

**Extended hours begin and continue all week**

Tuesday, Sept. 10 - first day for Nursery classes and T/Th/F PreK (G) class

Shortened day from **9:30-11 (am)**

Parents stay for meeting

*\* No TK classes*

*\*No fourth day Pre-k classes (will begin next week)*

Wednesday, Sept. 11 – first day for Toddler/Parent class – 9:00-10:30

first day for W/F TOTS – shortened day **9:30-11**

Parents stay for meeting

**Normal day for Pre-k/Tk classes 9-12:00**

Thursday, Sept. 12 – normal day for Nursery – 9-12:00

normal day for PreK and T-K classes – 9-12:00

Friday, Sept. 13 – normal day for Pre-k/Tk classes

Normal day for TOTS – 9-12:00

Our themes for September are:

Toddler/Parent – familiar songs

TOTS – ocean, all about me

Nursery – ocean, fall, apples, feelings, names

Pre-k and T-k – ocean, water, sand, summer, ecology

**Please make sure that if you have not already provided one, you bring a medical form and picture of your child on the first day. They will also need a backpack or tote bag.** The first day can be a little tense for your child and yourself. Just remember that this is a positive step in your child's life and he/she will make new friends, learn, and have fun here! As difficult as it may be, the best thing for parents to do is to bring your child in to the class with confidence, stay only as long as it takes to meet the teacher, find their cubby box, hang up the backpack, and then give a kiss and leave. Most children adapt very well and if there are tears, they usually stop after Mom/Dad leave.
