

Hebrew Bible Passages Mentioning the Widow, Orphan, and Immigrant (CEB)

Deuteronomy 10:18

God enacts justice for the orphan and the widow, and loves the immigrant, giving food and clothing.

Deuteronomy 14:29

Then the Levite, because he has no share or inheritance with you, the immigrant, the orphan, and the widow who live in your towns, will come and eat until they are full. Do this so that the LORD your God may bless you in everything you do.

Deuteronomy 16:11

Rejoice before the LORD your God—you, your sons and daughters, your male and female servants, the Levite who lives in your town, and the immigrant, the orphan, and the widow who are among you—at the location the LORD your God selects to establish his name.

Deuteronomy 16:14

Rejoice during your festival—you, your sons and daughters, your male and female servants, the Levite, the immigrant, the orphan, and the widow who live in your towns.

Deuteronomy 24:17

Don't deprive the immigrant or the orphan of justice, and don't take a widow's garment as collateral.

Deuteronomy 24:19

When you harvest the grain in your field and forget a bundle in the field, don't go back to get it. It belongs to the immigrant, the orphan, and the widow, so that the LORD your God may bless you in everything you do.

Deuteronomy 24:20

When you beat your olive trees, don't strip the branches afterward. That will go to the immigrant, the orphan, and the widow.

Deuteronomy 24:21

When you harvest the grapes in your vineyard, don't pick it over again afterward. That will go to the immigrant, the orphan, and the widow.

Deuteronomy 26:12–13

When you have finished paying all the tenth of your produce in the third year, the year of the tenth, give it to the Levite, the immigrant, the orphan, and the widow so that they may eat their fill in your towns. Then you will say before the LORD your God: "I have cleared out the sacred portion from the house, and I have also given it to the Levite, the immigrant, the orphan, and the widow, just as you commanded me. I haven't transgressed or forgotten any of your commands."

Deuteronomy 27:19

Cursed is anyone who deprives the immigrant, the orphan, and the widow of justice. And all the people will say, "Amen!"

Psalm 94:6

They kill widows and immigrants, and murder orphans.

Jeremiah 7:6

If you don't oppress the immigrant, the orphan, and the widow, and don't shed innocent blood in this place, and don't follow other gods to your own ruin...

Jeremiah 22:3

The LORD proclaims: Do justice and righteousness, rescue from the power of the oppressor anyone who has been robbed. Don't mistreat or harm the immigrant, the orphan, or the widow. Don't shed innocent blood in this place.

Ezekiel 22:7

In you they have treated father and mother with contempt; in you they have oppressed the immigrant; in you they have mistreated the orphan and the widow.

Zechariah 7:10

Don't oppress the widow, the orphan, the immigrant, or the poor, and don't plan evil against each other.

Malachi 3:5

I will come near you for judgment. I will be a quick witness against sorcerers, adulterers, and those who swear falsely, against those who oppress hired workers in their wages, widows, orphans, and against those who deny justice to the immigrant and don't fear me, says the LORD of heavenly forces.
